* How to Prevent Family Caregiver Premature Mortality

Globally, at least one-third of family caregivers are likely to die before their loved ones, usually of a stress-related illness. Rest and respite do not go far enough to maintain quality of life. When caregiving shifts from service to servitude, everyone loses.

Takeaways: How families can and must share the burden instead of imperiling the caregiver. How professionals can nurture that change.

* How to Reframe Your Caregiving Commitment: An interactive Session to Reclaim Your Compassion

An interactive session designed for participants to complete a stress check and assessment of their personal goals apart from caregiving. While professionals may suggest reclaiming your time, it's difficult for kind caregivers to achieve.

Takeaways: Measure your stressors and create a heart map for a new path forward. An interactive, participatory session that shares stories and solutions to reinforce these new understandings of strengths and boundaries.

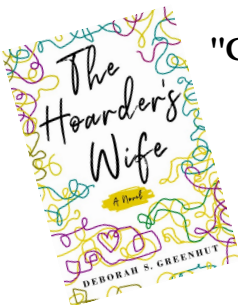
